### Yarn

Knitted in Louisa Harding Yarns Tulla Tweed

A. Sh. 108 Moray					
2	2	2	3	3 x 100g balls	
B. Sh. 103 Paisley					
2	2	2	3	3 x 100g ballss	

### Needles

5.5 mm (US 9) circular knitting needle

6 mm (US 10) circular knitting needle

Stitch markers

### Tension/gauge

18 sts x 26 rows to 10 cm (4 in) square measured over patt using 6 mm (US 10) circular knitting needle once blocked.

### Abbreviations

**beg** begin(s); beginning, **cont** continue(s); continuing, **dec(s)** decrease(s); decreasing, **fol** follow(s); following,

**inc(s)** increase(s); increasing, **K** knit, **M1** make one (increase), **P** purl, **patt(s)** pattern(s),

**psso** pass slipped stitch over, **rem** remain(s); remaining, **rep** repeat(s); repeating, **RS** right side,

**st** stitch(es), **st st** stocking (stockinette) stitch, **SM** slip marker, **yo** yarn over, **K2tog** knit next 2 sts together, (1 stitch decrease),

**SSK** slip 2 sts knitwise one at a time from the LH needle to the RH needle, insert LH needle tip through both front loops and knit together, (1 stitch decrease), **WS** wrong side.

**Note:** This garment is designed to be reversible. The reverse side of the garment is illustrated in the photographs.

### Back and front (worked in the round up to underarm shaping)

Using 5.5 mm (US 9) circular needle and yarn A cast on

144(152:160:168:176) sts)

Join stitches and work 16 rounds in striped garter st as folls:

**Edging round 1:** Using yarn A - knit, place a stitch marker to denote the beg/end of round.

**Edging round 2:** Using yarn A - purl, SM - slip stitch marker.

**Edging round 3:** Using yarn A - knit, SM.

**Edging round 4:** Using yarn A - purl, SM.

Work rounds 3 & 4 once more

**Edging round 7:** Using yarn B - knit, SM.

**Edging round 8:** Using yarn B - purl, SM.

**Edging round 9:** Using yarn A - knit, SM.

**Edging round 10:** Using yarn A - purl, SM.

Work rounds 7 - 10 once more

**Edging round 15:** Using yarn B - knit, SM.

**Edging round 16:** Using yarn B - purl, SM.

Change to 6 mm (US 10) circular needle and work 24 rounds in striped st st and rev st st patt as folls:

**Patt rounds 1 - 8:** Using Yarn A - knit, SM.

**Patt rounds 9 - 12:** Using Yarn A - purl, SM.

**Patt rounds 13 - 16:** Using Yarn B - purl, SM.

**Patt rounds 17 - 24:** Using Yarn B - knit, SM.

These 24 rounds form the stripe sequence used throughout the pattern.

Work stripe rounds 1 - 24 once more.

Work stripe rounds 1 - 23.

(71 patt rounds worked - approx. 30 cm (12 in) from cast on edge)

### Work underarm shaping

**Next round:** Using yarn B - K68(72:76:80:84) sts, cast off 8 sts,

K64(68:72:76:80), cast off 4 sts, remove stitch marker, cast off 4 sts.

(128(136:144:152:160) sts

Leave the rem sts on a holder for start of yoke.

### Sleeves (worked in the round up to underarm shaping)

Using 5.5 mm (US 9) circular needle and yarn A cast on

40(40:40:48:48) sts)

Join stitches and work 16 rounds in striped garter st as folls:

**Edging round 1:** Using yarn A - knit, place a stitch marker to denote the beg/end of round.

**Edging round 2:** Using yarn A - purl, SM - slip stitch marker.

**Edging round 3:** Using yarn A - knit, SM.

**Edging round 4:** Using yarn A - purl, SM.

Work rounds 3 & 4 once more

**Edging round 7:** Using yarn B - knit, SM.

**Edging round 8:** Using yarn B - purl, SM.

**Edging round 9:** Using yarn A - knit, SM.

**Edging round 10:** Using yarn A - purl, SM.

Work rounds 7 - 10 once more

**Edging round 15:** Using yarn B - knit, SM.

**Edging round 16:** Using yarn B - purl, SM.

Change to 6 mm (US 10) circular needle and work 24 rounds in striped st st and rev st st patt as folls:

**Patt rounds 1 (inc):** Using Yarn A – K3, M1, K to last 3 sts, M1, K3, SM.  
(42(42:42:50:50) sts)

**Patt rounds 2 - 8:** Knit, SM.

**Patt rounds 9 (inc):** Using Yarn A – P3, M1P, P to last 3 sts, M1P, P3, SM.  
(44(44:44:52:52) sts)

**Patt rounds 10 - 12:** Using Yarn A – purl, SM.

**Patt rounds 13 - 16:** Using Yarn B – purl, SM.

**Patt rounds 17 (inc):** Using Yarn B – K3, M1, K to last 3 sts, M1, K3, SM.  
(46(46:46:54:54) sts)

**Patt rounds 18 - 24:** Using Yarn B – knit, SM.

Work stripe rounds 1 - 24 3 times more. (64(64:64:72:72) sts)

Work stripe rounds 1 - 23 without any increases.

(119 patt rounds worked – approx. 50 cm (20 in) from cast on edge)

### Work underarm shaping

**Next round:** Using yarn B - K60(60:60:68:68) sts, cast off cast off 4 sts, remove stitch marker, cast off 4 sts. (56(56:56:64:64) sts)

Leave the rem sts on a holder for start of yoke.

### Join pieces for yoke

With RS of back facing and using 6 mm (US 10) circular needle and yarn A, K64(68:72:76:80) across sts left on holder for back, place stitch marker, K56(56:56:64:64) sts left on holder for 1st sleeve, place stitch marker, K64(68:72:76:80) across sts left on holder for front, place stitch marker, K56(56:56:64:64) sts left on holder for 2nd sleeve, place stitch marker, this last marker indicates end/beg of each round.  
(240(248:256:280:288) sts)

Now work in rounds.

**Next round:** Using yarn A - Knit across back to first marker, SM - slip marker, knit across 1st sleeve to 2nd marker, SM, knit across front to 3rd marker, SM, knit across 2nd sleeve to 4th marker, SSM.

**Cont to work in stripe patt as set for body and sleeves working yoke decreases as folls:**

**Yoke round 1 (dec):** [K3, K2tog, K54(58:62:66:70), SSK, K3, SM, K3, K2tog, K46(46:46:54:54), SSK, K3, SM,] twice. (232(240:248:272:280) sts)

**Yoke round 2:** [K62(66:70:74:78), SM, K54(54:54:62:62), SM,] twice.

**Yoke round 3 (dec):** [K3, K2tog, K52(56:60:64:68), SSK, K3, SM, K3, K2tog, K44(44:44:52:52), SSK, K3, SM,] twice. (224(232:240:264:272) sts)

**Yoke round 4:** [K60(64:68:72:76), SM, K52(52:52:60:60), SM,] twice.

The last 2 rounds form the yoke dec patt.

Work a further 32(34:36:40:41) rounds in patt. (96(96:96:104:104) sts)

On the last round remove all stitch markers apart from last marker denoting beg/end of round.

### Neck edging

Using yarn B change to 5.5 mm (US 7) circular needle and work in garter st as folls:

**Edging round 1:** Using B - knit, SM.

**Edging round 2:** Using B - Purl, SM.

**Edging round 3:** Using A - Knit, SM.

**Edging round 4:** Using A - Purl, SM.

Work these 4 rounds twice more.

**1st, 2nd & 3rd sizes**

**Edging round 13 (dec):** Using A - (K10, K2tog) 8 times, SM. (88 sts)

**4th & 5th sizes**

**Edging round 13 (dec):** Using A - (K6, K2tog) 13 times, SM. (91 sts)

**All sizes**

**Edging round 14:** Using A - Purl, SM.

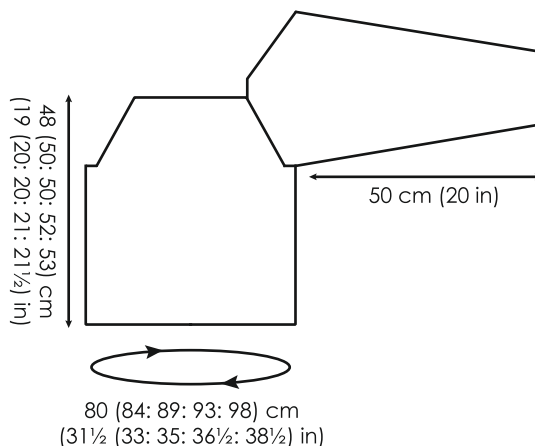
**Edging round 15:** Using A - Knit, SM.

Turn work and cast off knitwise on **WS**, taking care not to pull sts too tightly.

### Blocking

Sew in all ends, join underarm cast off stitches using edge to edge stitch.

Block sweater as instructions given on yarn label to the dimensions given.
