## NEEDLES

1 pair 3.25 mm (no 10) (US 3) needles 1 pair 4 mm (no 8) (US 6) needles 3.25 mm (no 10) (US 3) circular needle Cable needle

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(Shown in Rose 1008)

## TENSION

 $21\frac{1}{2}$  sts and 27 rows to 10 cm (4 in) measured over st st using 4 mm (US 6) needles. Cable panel (15 sts) measures 4.5 cm ( $1\frac{3}{4}$  in).

It is vitally important to check your tension before starting your item as the tension governs the finished size. If you work to the wrong tension, your item will not be the size shown in the photograph and you may run out of yarn, or need to buy more.

Check your tension by knitting a swatch at least 12 cm (5 in) square. If there are more sts and rows to 10 cm (4 in) than stated, try again using thicker needles. If there are less sts and rows to 10 cm (4 in) than stated, try again using thinner needles.

# **PP** SIMPLE TE(HNIQUES

Simple straight forward knitting, introducing various shaping techniques and garments.

#### NoTE

Yarn quantities are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

Instructions are given for the smallest size, with changes for larger sizes given in square brackets [].

Repeat figures in round brackets ( ) the number of times stated afterwards.

Where only one figure is given, this relates to all sizes.

Where the figure 0 appears, no sts, times or rows are worked for this size.

Colour reproduction is as close as printing process will allow.

#### BA()

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x 100g

Using 3.25 mm (US 3) needles cast on 127 [139: 151: 163: 177: 189] sts.

Row 1 (RS): K1, \*P1, K1, rep from \* to end.

**Row 2:** P1, \*K1, P1, rep from \* to end.

These 2 rows form rib.

Cont in rib for a further 21 rows, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Change to 4 mm (US 6) needles.

**Row 24 (WS):** P3 [1: 7: 5: 4: 2], P2tog, (P6, P2tog) 15 [17: 17: 19: 21: 23] times, P2 [0: 6: 4: 3: 1]. 111 [121: 133: 143: 155: 165] sts.

Beg with a K row, now work in st st throughout as folls: Cont straight until Back meas  $44 \text{ cm } (17\frac{1}{4} \text{ in})$ , ending with RS facing for next row.

### SHAPE RAGLAN ARMHOLES

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 105 [115: 127: 137: 149: 159] sts.

**Next row (RS):** K1, P1, K1, K2tog, K to last 5 sts, sl 1, K1, psso, K1, P1, K1.

**Next row:** K2, P1, P2tog tbl, P to last 5 sts, P2tog, P1, K2. Rep last 2 rows 1 [4: 8: 11: 15: 19] times more. 97 [95: 91: 89: 85: 79] sts.

**Next row (RS):** K1, P1, K1, K2tog, K to last 5 sts, sl 1, K1, psso, K1, P1, K1.

**Next row:** K2, P to last 2 sts, K2.

Rep last 2 rows 28 [26: 24: 22: 20: 17] times more, ending with RS facing for next row.

Break yarn and leave rem 39 [41: 41: 43: 43: 43] sts on a holder (for Collar).

#### FRONT

Work as given for Back until 53 [55: 57: 59: 61: 61] sts rem in raglan armhole shaping.

Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

#### SHAPE FRONT NECK

**Next row (RS):** K1, P1, K1, K2tog, K6 [6: 8: 8: 10: 10] and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder.

Work on this set of 10 [10: 12: 12: 14: 14] sts only for first side of neck as folls:

Keeping raglan armhole decreases correct as set, dec 1 st at neck edge of next 3 [3: 4: 4: 4: 4] rows, then on foll 0 [0: 0: 0: 1: 1] alt row **and at same time** dec 1 st as set at raglan armhole edge of 2nd and foll 0 [0: 1: 1: 2: 2] alt rows. 6 sts.

Work 0 [0: 1: 1: 1: 1] row, ending with RS facing for next row.

**Next row (RS):** K1, P1, K1, sl 1, K2tog, psso.

Next row: P2, K2. Next row: K1, P3tog.

Next row: K2.

Next row: P2tog and fasten off.

Return to sts left on holder and slip centre 31 [33: 31: 33: 31: 31] sts onto another holder (for Collar). Rejoin yarn to rem sts with RS facing and cont as folls:

**Next row (RS):** K to last 5 sts, sl 1, K1, psso, K1, P1, K1. 10 [10: 12: 12: 14: 14] sts.

Keeping raglan armhole decreases correct as set, dec 1 st at neck edge of next 3 [3: 4: 4: 4] rows, then on foll 0 [0: 0: 0: 1: 1] alt row **and at same time** dec 1 st as set at raglan armhole edge of 2nd and foll 0 [0: 1: 1: 2: 2] alt rows. 6 sts. Work 0 [0: 1: 1: 1: 1] row, ending with RS facing for next row.

**Next row (RS):** K3tog, K1, P1, K1.

Next row: K2, P2. Next row: P3tog, K1.

Next row: K2.

**Next row:** P2tog and fasten off.

## LEFTSLEEVE

Using 3.25 mm (US 3) needles cast on 49 [51: 53: 55: 57: 59] sts.

Work in rib as given for Back for 17 rows, ending with **WS** facing for next row.

Change to 4 mm (US 6) needles.

**Row 18 (WS):** P20 [21: 22: 23: 24: 25], place marker on needle, (P1, M1P) 3 times, P3, (M1P, P1) 3 times, place 2nd marker on right needle, P to end. 55 [57: 59: 61: 63: 65] sts.\*\*

Now work in patt as folls:

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2 and every foll alt row: Purl.

**Row 3:** K to marker, slip marker onto right needle, K5, C10F, slip 2nd marker onto right needle, K to end.

**Row 5:** Inc in first st, K to last st, inc in last st. 57 [59: 61: 63: 65: 67] sts.

Row 7: Knit.

**Row 9:** K to marker, slip marker onto right needle, C10B, K5, slip 2nd marker onto right needle, K to end.

**Row 11:** As row 5. 59 [61: 63: 65: 67: 69] sts.

Row 12: Purl.

These 12 rows set the sts – cable panel worked between central markers and all other sts in st st.

\*\*\*Keeping sts correct throughout as now set, inc 1 st at each end of 5th and every foll 6th row to 81 [81: 91: 89: 97: 99] sts, then on every foll 8th row until there are 85 [87: -: 93: -: -] sts.

Cont straight until Sleeve meas 45 [46: 46: 47: 47: 47] cm  $(17\frac{3}{4} [18: 18: 18\frac{1}{2}: 18\frac{1}{2}] in)$ , ending with RS facing for next row.

# SHAPE RAGLAN

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. 79 [81: 85: 87: 91: 93] sts. Working all raglan shaping in same way as raglan armhole shaping, dec 1 st at each end of next and foll 4th row, then on every foll alt row until 25 sts rem.

Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row.

### SHAPE FOR FRONT NE(K

Keeping all raglan decreases correct, cast off 6 sts at beg of next and foll alt row, then 5 sts at beg of foll alt row **and at same time** dec 1 st at end of next and foll 2 alt rows. 5 sts. Work 1 row, ending with RS facing for next row. Cast off rem 5 sts.

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### RIGHT SLEEVE

Work as given for Left Sleeve to \*\*.

Now work in patt as folls:

Row 1 (RS): Knit.

Row 2 and every foll alt row: Purl.

**Row 3:** K to marker, slip marker onto right needle, C10B, K5, slip 2nd marker onto right needle, K to end.

**Row 5:** Inc in first st, K to last st, inc in last st. 57 [59: 61: 63: 65: 67] sts.

Row 7: Knit.

**Row 9:** K to marker, slip marker onto right needle, K5, C10F, slip 2nd marker onto right needle, K to end.

**Row 11:** As row 5. 59 [61: 63: 65: 67: 69] sts.

Row 12: Purl.

These 12 rows set the sts – cable panel worked between central markers and all other sts in st st.

Now work as given for Left Sleeve from \*\*\* to Shape for Front Neck.

## SHAPE FOR FRONT NE(K

Keeping all raglan decreases correct, cast off 5 sts at beg of 2nd row, 6 sts at beg of foll alt row, then 5 sts at beg of foll alt row, ending with RS facing for next row, **and at same time** dec 1 st at beg of next and foll 2 alt rows. 5 sts.

Cast off rem 5 sts.

#### MAKING UP

Join all raglan armhole seams.

#### (OLLAR

With RS facing and using 3.25 mm (US 3) circular needle, pick up and knit 19 sts from top of left sleeve, 8 [8: 10: 10: 12: 12] sts down left side of front neck, K across 31 [33: 31: 33: 31: 33] sts on front holder, pick up and knit 8 [8: 10: 10: 12: 12] sts up right side of front neck, and 19 sts from top of right sleeve, then K across 39 [41: 41: 43: 43: 43] sts on back holder. 124 [128: 130: 134: 136: 136] sts.

**Round 1 (RS):** \*K1, P1, rep from \* to end.

This round forms rib.

Cont in rib until Collar meas 8 cm  $(3\frac{1}{4}$  in) from pick-up round.

Cast off **loosely** in rib.

Join side and sleeve seams.

Pin out garment to measurements given, cover with damp cloths and leave to dry naturally. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.
